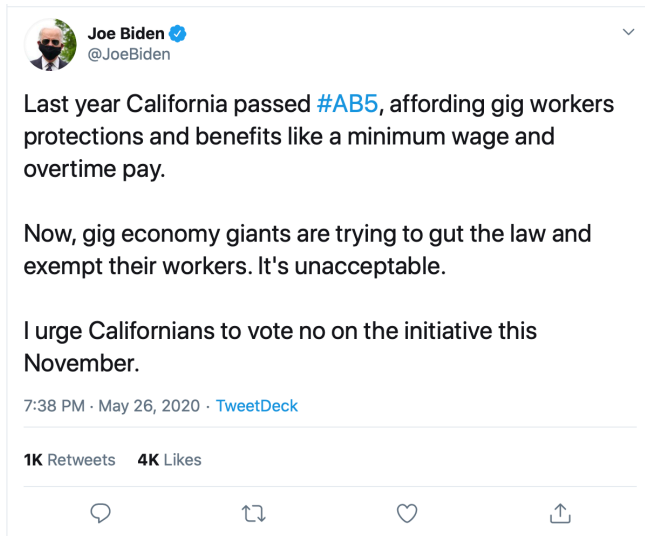

Breaking: Biden Urges Californians to Slam the Brakes on Uber/Lyft Initiative

Sacramento, CA -- Presumptive Democratic Presidential Nominee Joe Biden took a strong “No” position on Uber, Lyft, Doordash, Instacart and Postmates’ misguided November ballot initiative in a [tweet](#) Tuesday night. “I urge Californians to vote no on the initiative this November,” Biden said.



Biden called the gig corporations’ effort “gut the law” to buy themselves a special exemption from California law “unacceptable.”

The most recent public campaign finance report shows the companies’ ballot measure account had \$99 million on hand as they campaign for a loophole that would let them keep cheating workers out of wages, benefits and workplace protections and shift their costs onto taxpayers.
